ZionCare App (Sleep Therapy Technology)

Developed iOS and Android apps using React Native. This app focuses on connecting physical devices to record sleep data and uses algorithms to generate medical-grade sleep reports, allowing users to conduct detailed sleep testing at home, replacing traditional sleep center services. In this project, I was responsible for extensively using custom hooks to wrap axios API requests and refactored legacy JS code to TypeScript, making type definitions clearer and easier to debug. I also utilized useCallback and useMemo to reduce unnecessary page re-renders, improving UI smoothness and reducing unnecessary API calls. Throughout the process, I used ESLint and Prettier global settings to establish co-work coding standards. For internationalization, I used Lingui for Chinese-English translation, and for user input validation, I used Zod with react-hook-form to ensure data accuracy.

ZionCare Web Portal

Developed a visual dashboard using React.js to help medical institutions monitor patient dynamics.

In this project, I was responsible for using various UI and chart libraries like Ant Design to create highly customized big data visualizations. I applied all the refactoring techniques from the App project, including JS to TS conversion, custom hooks, render optimization, and more.

Built and maintained multiple websites using WordPress and Elementor.

This is one of my ongoing side projects. Its core purpose is to solve the closed ecosystem problem in pet healthcare. Starting from initial WordPress development, then moving to React.js + Node.js for frontend-backend separation, and finally to Next.js full-stack integration. Beyond work-related skills, I've also learned to use sockets for real-time information updates and TailwindCSS for web animations to enhance user experience. For the app, I use React Native with Expo on Windows to create iOS and Android applications. I'm currently learning more about frontend-backend data interaction, web animations, and automated deployment through various side projects.
